At this time the Division of the Arts will be offering Stabilization grants, which will provide general operating support to Louisiana arts organizations and institutions.

The Stabilization Program seeks to support nonprofit 501(c) 3 arts organizations that help to create, present, and preserve the various unique arts resources in Louisiana. The Stabilization Program provides grants to arts organizations that impact Louisiana constituents. Stabilization grants provide general operating funds in three funding categories. They are (1) Institution, (2) Advancement, and (3) Entry. Tiers are designed in relation to an organization's budget size. Your tier is determined by your organization budget for the last completed fiscal year. Please consult Division of the Arts staff if you have questions regarding your application tier.

| Tier Level | Organization Budget | Estimated Grant Range |
|-------------------|----------------------------|------------------------------|
| (1) Institution | \$1 million or more | \$20,000 - \$45,000 |
| (2) Advancement | \$250,000 to \$1 million | \$9,000 - \$20,000 |
| (3) Entry | \$30,000 to \$250,000 | \$1,500 - \$9,000 |
