ANNUAL DAY-USE PERMITS FOR DCFS CAREGIVERS

TO: Office of State Parks' Employees

RE: Annual Day-Use Permits for DCFS Caregivers
DATE: November 14, 2024

The Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, Office of State Parks ("DCRT-OSP") has partnered with the Department of Children and Family Services ("DCFS") to offer free annual day-use permits to Certified Foster Caregivers and Relative/Kin Caregivers (both referenced as "Caregivers" for remainder of memorandum). These annual day-use permits will be for all state parks, state historic sites, and other DCRT properties as specified.

To receive the free annual day-use permit, a Caregiver will complete an application at lastateparks.com. DCRT-OSP will verify that the Caregiver is in good standing with DCFS and mail the permit to the address provided in the application. Annual day-use permits for Caregivers are valid for one year. Upon expiration, a Caregiver will need to submit a new application at lastateparks.com so their standing with DCFS can be reverified. Additionally, all people accompanying a Caregiver permit holder will be admitted into the site free of charge (see Title 25 §502.F.1.). Sites will select "Annual Park Pass – DCFS Caregiver" in the CRS system when presented with the pass (see attached sample).

The administrative office is responsible for issuing annual day-use permits for Caregivers.
