SUBJECT: New Protective Services Pay Plan

Civil Service is in the process of creating six new pay schedules over the next few years to replace the General Schedule. Each classified job title will be evaluated by Civil Service and assigned to the appropriate pay schedule depending upon duties and job functions.

The first pay schedule approved was the Protective Services Pay Schedule which was approved by Governor Mike Foster on September 23, 2002. A copy is attached.

All law enforcement positions have been removed from the General Schedule (GS) and are now in the new Protective Services Schedule (PS). Listed below are job titles in the department affected by this schedule. The new PS level and yearly salary ranges are also included.

Park Ranger 2	PS 106	\$19,632 - \$33,384
Park Ranger Specialist	PS 109	\$24,072 - \$40,896
Police Chief/ State Museum	PS 116	\$38,664 - \$65,688
Police Corporal/ State Museum	PS 107	\$21,012 - \$35,712
Police Officer 1/ State Museum	PS 105	\$18,348 - \$31,200
Police Officer 2/ State Museum	PS 106	\$19,632 - \$33,384
Police Sergeant/ State Museum	PS 109	\$24,072 - \$40,896

The new PS schedule only affects employees below the new minimum. The salaries of those affected have been adjusted accordingly.
