Being imprisoned for over two years, he escaped on a Sunday through a hole he had cut in the prison wall the day before, taking with him a hatchet but no arms, intending to go back to his home with his father. Not having any compass, they expected to be guided by the sun and to live on fish.

They went out west, following a muddy road and passed the night at Sieur Dubreuil's enclosure, where they were retaken.
